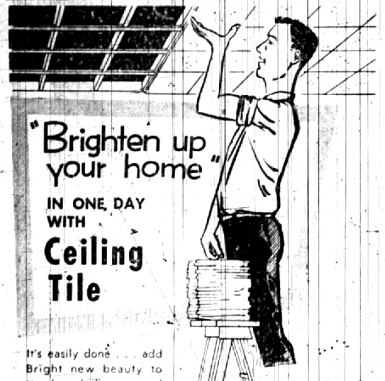

Students Entering Baking Contests

Entries in the top and side baking contests will be judged as part of the varsity show, scheduled for next Thursday and Friday. A ten dollar prize will go to the first place winner of each contest.

One entry may enter in either or both classifications. The contest rules require that all entries be baked by students. An identifying number will be given each entry. Entries also may be submitted by next Monday, 7:00 p.m. Friday. The deadline is 4 p.m.

Thanksgiving Theme Of Band Ceremonies

An early American Thanksgiving will be the theme for the band's halftime show at the annual Birmingham Royal Oak Thanksgiving day football game.

A band signifying the landing of the Pilgrims, a church and a cross signifying the Puritans, the Pilgrims, and a tepee symbolizing the meeting between the Pilgrims and Indians will be among the formations the band will make.

The band has participated in every Thanksgiving day game in the 28 years that Director Arnold Berndt has been teaching in Birmingham.

Students Learning Rifle Technique

Under the direction of Sally Reid, Birmingham high school rifle team instructor, 20 girls students have learned the fundamentals of rifle firing and range procedure.

The program, which ends for the fall season this week, is a part of the GAA activities at the school. Kenneth A. MacLeod, instructor, emphasizes that the girls are to use the rifle in a safe manner, although many of the girls have become remarkably accurate shots.

Divided into two groups, beginners and advanced, the girls have participated in seven firing sessions at the police target range at the end of Cranbrook at East Lake. The girls are the only private individuals to use the range with police permission.

Firing is done with regulation and .22 caliber match quality rifles, the property of the Birmingham Rifle Club. Standard National Rifle Association targets are used, at a distance of 50 feet from the firing line.
