St. James Episcopal church will present its organist and choir, Kent McDonald, in a special recital on Nov. 22, when the new pipe organ will be formally dedicated. The Rev. Harold E. Towne will preside at a brief dedicatory service at 8 p.m., to be followed by McDonald's recital.

The recital will include "Introduction and Toccata, Walden Suite for Musical Chicks, Handel's "Basso continuo," "Pavane for Flute and Harp," "Two Chorales," "Come, Ye Sons of the Gentiles," and "Benedictus of Mass." He will also play "Toccata and Fugue in D Minor," Bach; "Choral in A Minor," Franck; "Prelude and Intermezzo," Scriabin; "Elegy," Bonnet; "Mourning Song," Harris; "Finnish Symphonies," Sibelius.

The organ was built especially for St. James church by the Kligon Manufacturing Co. of St. Louis and was installed last spring. The three-manual instrument has 19 stops and 37 tones.

Mr. Towne and McDonald will announce the dedication program on the part of the church.
