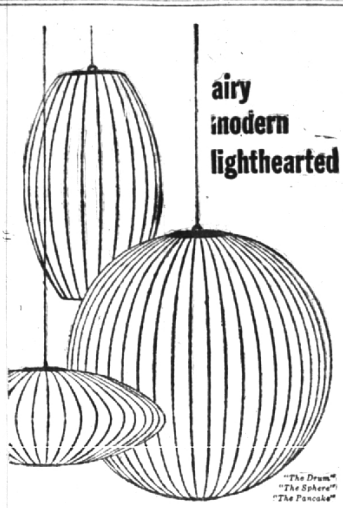
District 18 WCTU Meets Here Friday

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Teachers-Parents Participate in Panel Discussion

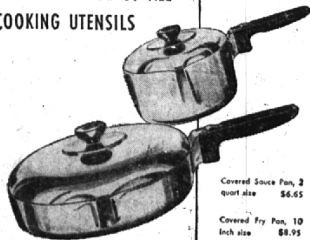

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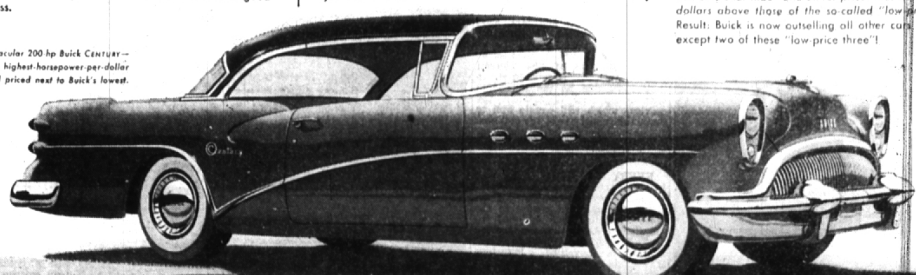
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
