Cranbrook Begins Phys. Ed. Program

This year Cranbrook school has adapted a new physical education program. The program is designed to give those boys who are unable to participate on varsity teams a chance to enjoy athletics and to derive the benefits of this activity.

At the beginning of each varsity season, the members of each team are chosen. All those not included on the teams are automatically placed in "Phys. Ed." and remain there for the remainder of the season.

In addition, all of the students are required to take physical fitness tests at the beginning and close of the school year. The tests include obstacle courses, strength, and endurance tests. The tests are averaged together and used to determine whether or not the student is gaining from the school's athletic program.

When a boy is placed in Phys. Ed. it means that he devotes one period each day to building and conditioning his body. The program consists of calisthenics, instruction in the various sports, and actual participation in these sports. By encouraging sportsmanship and fair play the program helps to develop a well-rounded individual.

Maples Trample Hazel Park 7-6

Hazel Park's first play from scrimmage provided enough points for the Birmingham gridblers to edge the Parkers 7-6 on their rain-drenched field last Friday night.

Captain Bill Watkinson intercepted Nick Kamenoff's surprise aerial on the contest's first play and slogged his way 29 yards to pay dirt to put the Maples out in front to stay. Watkinson added what proved to be the deciding extra point, and the fate of the game was determined before most of the fans even reached their seats.

The Vikings fought back strongly and bull-dozed their way down to the locals' two yard line before a slippery nickskin got away in the backfield and the Maples recovered. The hosts were back again knocking at the door later in the first period and their efforts paid off when Jack Brown slied around left end for 26 yards and a touch-down. Kamenoff, who couldn't seem to do anything right, missed the conversion attempt when his kick skidded wide to the left.

East Detroit comes to Birmingham tomorrow night for what should be an interesting contest since the Detroiters handed Port Huron their first loss in 19 League games last Friday.

STILL LATER in the initial quarter the Parkers again threatened, moving to the Maples' ten, but George Huffman pounced on a fumble in the backfield and the Maples took over to end the first real threat.

The second period settled down to a miffed duel of defenses. In the second half the Vikings attempted to drive deep into Maple territory but a stout defense held them back. Bill Swaney's great punting kept forcing the Parkers back into their own half of the field.

Birmingham Coach Carl Lemle said that this game was the best that the Maples have played so far this season. He lauded the defense for its work in the heavy going. Coach Lemle also singled out Watkinson as the kingpin for the locals on both offense and defense. Center Kirk Flack came in for praise for his accurate passes from center with the wet ball.

THE WHOLE TEAM contributed to the Maples' win which moved them out of the Eastern Michigan league cellar and raised them above the .500 mark.

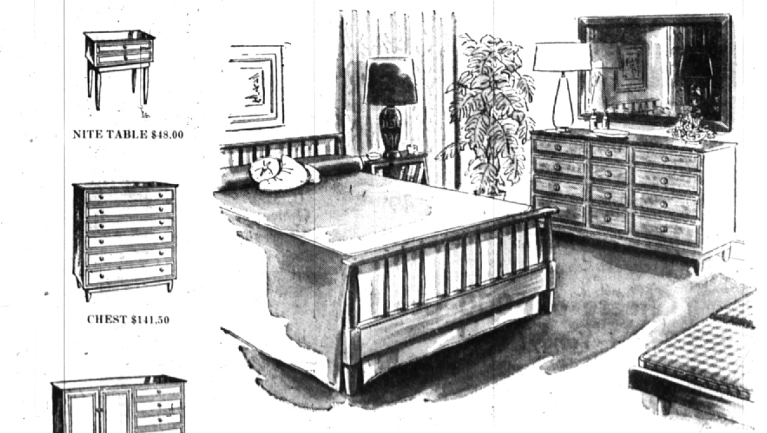
