Her audience was composed of public relations representatives of six leagues of the Detroit area. Considering the founding of a public relations committee for the area, Mrs. Lurie told of such activities in the Boston area. While one speaks of the public, there are really many publics, she told the group of women. Conveying one's message to as many as possible should utilize radio, television, the metropolitan press and small group publications as well as local newspapers, she said. League delegates from Detroit, Grosse Pointe Woods, West Bloomfield, Pleasant Ridge, and Ferndale joined Birmingham league in the meeting, which resulted in naming of a planning committee.

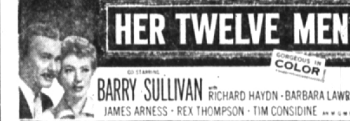
