## Maple Gridders Down E. Detroit

Birmingham's surprising Maples marched for 54 yards and a third period tie-breaking score to upset East Detroit 13-6 and move into a four-way second place league tie last Friday night before a thrilled near-capacity crowd in the Birmingham high school stadium.

Spurred by some excellent work in both the offensive and defensive lines, the locals capped their second scoring march when quarterback Bill Swaney let go with a 24 yard spiral to end Bill Watkins on the 2 yard line. Captain Watkins stepped across for the six-pointer unopposed. The Maples took the Shamrock kickoff and held on to the pike until they tallied the winning TD. Watkins split the uprights with his conversion.

PREVIOUSLY in the opening stanza Birmingham put together a 60 yard march for the initial score of the evening. Swaney's passing and hard-charging Wayne Goggin pushed the visitors farther and farther back into their own territory. Right halfback John Appleford scooted the last yard for a 6-0 Maple edge. Watkins' conversion attempt was wide to the left.

Early in the second quarter East Detroit quarterback Hank Alter passed 24 yards successfully to Lynn Cole to knot the count at six all. Guard Frank Brissinger missed the point.

The Shamrocks threatened constantly with their aerial attack, but an aggressive local forward well headed by junior Jim Traa consistently bottlenecked the bewildered green and white backs.

In the second period Traa smothered an East Detroit threat on Birmingham's ten yard stripe when he broke through to move the ball to the 21 from where an East Detroit mercenary, the field goal, was attempted. However, it fell short to snuff the hopes of the visitors.

IN THE FINAL quarter Traa and guard Dave Spehar jointly threw the Shamrocks' Alter for a nine yard loss back to the Birmingham 17. On the next play alert Appleford intercepted a pass to squelch another Detroit scoring attempt.

Following the battle in which three players were ejected Coach Carl Lemie said of his Maples that it was their best game of the year, surpassing the previous week's Hazel Park encounter.

Tomorrow night at eight o'clock league leading Port Huron will entertain the Maples in the Blue Water stadium.
