

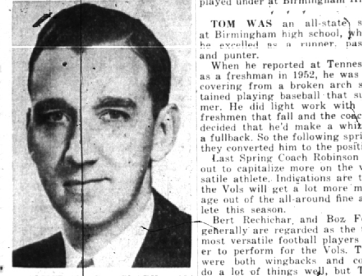
Knoxville Sportswriter Lauds Work of Tracy
