

Two-Day Institute At Vaughan School

BLOOMFIELD HILLS — Approximately 70 educators will attend a two-day workshop for teachers in the city school system convening September 2 and 3 at Vaughan school.

Some 15 new teachers will be introduced at this time. Highlight of the two-day program will be a luncheon Thursday attended by school board members, their wives, teachers and faculty administrators.

The program each day will last from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Thursday's program will incorporate a panel discussion of major education problems led by Mrs. Don Dolan and Ray Kihoe, education consultants from the University of Michigan.

Friday's agenda will be devoted to discussions of subject matter concerning "Visual Aid and Youth Education," and a demonstration of operation of a movie projector.
