

## Overnight Y Camp Set for May 20-21

## BHS Thinclads Have too Much Depth for Jays

Birmingham had too much depth for Southfield high school's track team. The Maples romped over the Jays 75½-33½ by taking eight firsts and tying for a ninth at Pierce field Tuesday.

It was the season opener for coach Kermit Ambrose and his thinclads, and the third straight loss for Southfield.

GORDON PEADÉ topped the Maple scoring with 13 points. He won the high hurdles and tied for first in the high jump at 5'3" and in the low hurdles at 13:05.

Tony Evangelista copped honors in the 220 dash and took third in the 100 and broad jump events.

SOUTHFIELD took first place in the broad jump with Fred Heinecke taking the jump at 18'5".

In the mile run, which was one of the closer events of the meet, Jack Low of Southfield had a time of 5:00 flat.

For the third time this season, Bluejay shot put star Bob Quirk bettered or tied the school record with 46'3", however he could not match Ed Peters' fine put of 46'5".

In a relatively slow 100 yard dash, Birmingham's Bill Dove and Fred Courville of Southfield tied with 10:8 time.

AT HAZEL PARK last weekend, the Southfield cindermen dropped a 64-45 decision with Gordon Hart, Bob Quirk and Fred Courville leading the Jays.

Hart took 10 points by winning the high and low hurdles and although he was little off his 45 form Quirk won the shot put with 44'1¼".

JACK BROWN of Hazel Park was top man of the meet with 16½ points as winner of the high jump, broad jump, 440 yard, and member of the relay team.

Still hoping to crack the victory column, coach Monte Charles will work the team until his May 3 meet at Walled Lake.

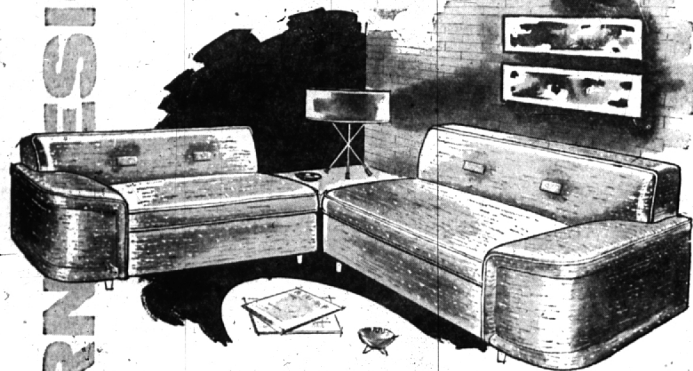
