

"Search Their Souls"

For Buffer Compromise

All of the factions primarily concerned in the proposed Eton buffer strip are this week "searching their souls" for a solution or compromise which will help to decide the issue at Monday's city commission meeting.

At Monday's session of the commission all interested parties were recognized, but after two hours of deliberation and discussion, no decision was reached. Subsequently Mayor Pro Tem James C. Allen called on everyone to "search their souls" with respect to deciding the issue at the next meeting.

ACCORDING to Dean G. Bear, the commission had no authority to withhold the building permits, however Rand agreed to applying for another week before holding for the permits.

The citizens objected to the types of homes which were planned for these lots, and they also opposed the proposed assessment for the buffer strip, which was being considered on the west side of Eton road for the benefit of the property owners between Eton and Columbia.

CITY MANAGER Donald C. Egbert said he hopes to consolidate the remaining 33 lots to be added to the clearing, grading and landscaping of the 24 lots.

A TOTAL right of way of 80 feet buffer strip, including 12 feet for sidewalks (six feet on each side) and a three lane pavement width of 41 feet, including curbs, will comprise the landscaped area, 21 feet of which would be on the west side.
