Fire Chief Lauds Auxiliary Training For Fast Thinking

The experience gained by Victor F. Ulrich, 559 Southfield, as an auxiliary fireman during the war, may have saved his home and possibly the life of members of his family Tuesday.

Ulrich had just finished cleaning out the debris of a burning furnace, and was preparing to leave the house about 8:20 p.m. with his son, when the boy spotted a fire in the basement.

WITH COOL presence of mind, Ulrich led the members of his family to safety, closed all exits from the basement to prevent the fire from spreading and called the fire department.

Ulrich, a former fireman, extinguished the blaze and estimated the damage of \$1,000 to the basement and \$500 loss on contents.

"HIS PRESENCE of mind and quick thinking, prevented what could have been a disastrous result," said fire chief Vernon Griffith, in commending Ulrich's action.

According to Griffith the fire started when a hot coal fell into a kindling box near the furnace.
