Fertilizer Spray Methods Developed for Home Lawns

Soak perhaps this year, an oil truck will pull up to your door, but instead of winter fuel, it will be delivering a supply of liquid fertilizer spray for your lawn or garden.

Liquid spray has been used successfully on many golf courses, but until recently residential or small business green areas were fertilized with other methods, if at all.

Pioneering in this new-type fertilizer will be the Torrence Oil Company of Birmingham, which is now in the process of testing the needs of the through traffic. This testing follows an eight-month investigation prior to the oil firm's acceptance of the Michigan franchise to distribute the spray.

FOR TORRENCE it means a summer business and a means of keeping their personnel intact. It takes two days of cleaning to convert an oil truck over to use for the spray fertilizer.

It is estimated that a 50x125 lawn can be sprayed in 15 minutes, with two spring applications and one in the fall, needed to supply the lawn's requirements.

Pumping equipment already installed for oil will pump out the spray through a 3/4-inch high pressure hose, or the liquid sprayer on wheels.

Indicate Need for Bypasses

Does a small town need bypasses? Studies have shown that as the towns grow smaller, the amount of traffic passing through the town increases, per centage-wise, according to a report released recently by the Detroit Regional Planning Commission.

About 52 per cent of the traffic which approaches a town of less than 5000 passes through without stopping, the report indicated.

This through-traffic decreases until in cities of 500,000 persons or more, only about seven per cent does not stop.

IN QUOTING a publication by the U. S. Chamber of Commerce, the commission pointed out that the uses of by-passes may be a solution to the reawakening of the downtown centers of our smaller communities.

"By removing from the main street the large amounts of through traffic, the business districts will gain. Vehicles in the act of parking will not interfere with the through vehicles," the report indicated.

"The actual time required to drive to the center will be shortened for the residents of the community as the main streets will not be overcrowded with through traffic. The roads of the business district will serve the needs of the shuttling businesses; and the bypasses, if properly constructed as limited access roads, will serve the needs of the through traffic," the report continued.
