Field Marks Fall in Maple Track Victory

Two records fell when the Birmingham track team rolled over Waterford 79 1/2-29 1/2 last Friday at Pierce field where the Maples took ten firsts and swept all places in the shotput.

Breaking his own Pierce field record of 24.1, Gordon Pate set a new mark in the 120 yard high hurdles with a time of :15.7.

BIRMINGHAM'S Joe Kidwell smashed the 115 yard low hurdles mark of :13.4 set by East Detroit's Ron Kramer in 1952 with a record time of :13 flat. In setting the record, Kidwell also equaled the low hurdle mark set in 1945 by team of Bob Thomas, Sellner, Bucky Zoellin, in whose memory the Zoellin Memorial for outstanding achievement in the State meet was established.

An exciting race developed when Maple Bob Libby came from behind in the final yards to beat out Waterford's Darrel Adams and Bill Clark in the 440 yard dash with a time of :56.2.

TENSION mounted in the high jump when Maples Dick Schmiel and Pade battled it out for first place inch by inch in a contest which finally resulted in a 5 5/8" tie.

Ed Peters heave of 46' 2 1/4" took first in the shotput followed by Doug O'Gamb and Bob Holmeyer in second and third.

IN THE 100 yard dash Maple Bill Dove took first with 10.4 and Dave Long finished the 880 yard run in the top spot with 2:0.4.

Ron McCrumb and Bill McFarlen shared first in the pole vault, clearing 10' 11" and an 18' 9 1/4" leap gave McDonald a first in the broad jump. 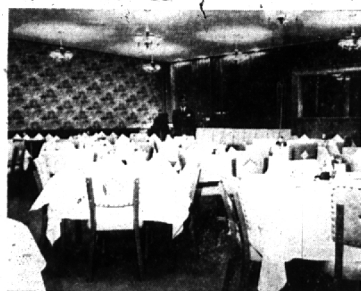
