Christ Church Building Starts School to Use Soon on Franklin Seabury Units Village Church

With the completion of the "Seabury Series" of Christian Education, Christ Church (Franklin) will have this method of teaching available to children in the first, fourth and seventh church school grades. The Seabury method has been in the experimental field for about nine years and has recently been published for these three grades.

At a recent meeting of the Franklin Community church congregation, the building committee received a unanimous vote to complete final details for an early start on the construction of the new church.

Three steps were recommended. One, that present plans be approved for the new structure; two, that the sanctuary be built and furnished as planned with the instructional and office section to be built but without furnishing; and three, that the social hall and classrooms on the ground floor be temporarily omitted.

Space under the sanctuary will be used temporarily as the social hall and kitchen.

ARRANGEMENTS have been made with the contractors to add any or all defective items should funds become available during the construction period.

Building funds now total \$147,722 in cash and pledges, a sharp increase from the \$6,000 last December but still far below the \$350,000 for the entire project.

Obver Garwood, presenting Vernon Fisher's report, said church architects in New York, Philadelphia and Detroit had seen the plans and given hearty approval.

HE ADDED that after consultation with church and community groups as to their needs, the floor space of the church had been mostly
