The squadron will stop at Edinburgh, Scotland, Copenhagen, Denmark, Oslo and Bergen, Norway and Stockholm, Sweden.



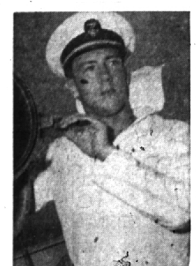

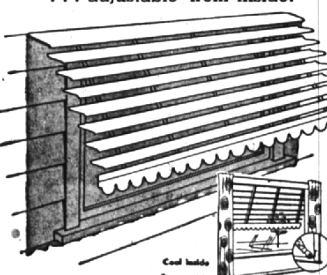

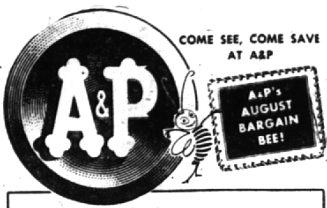
