Cromwell, Franklin, an associate of the Detroit Steel corporation, has been transferred to the New Haven, Conn., office, and is expected to move his family there as soon as possible. Adams has just returned from a two-weeks stay in the area during which time Hurricane Connie hit her with great force. She was devastated by the storm which struck there last week. Mrs. Adams said her experience in Connie was nothing spectacular but still gave her quite a fright. "WE WENT OUT in it to see the storm first-hand," she said. "The wind was terrific and the windshield wipers didn't have a chance at keeping up with the downpour. "Since then my husband has told me about the flood in his nightly calls home. Places I saw there damaged beyond destroyed or terribly damaged. "A very nice restaurant we stopped at in going along with about half the community. Whole sections are wiped out and others damaged. There's a great demand for steel and they're working day and night trying to get it. The firm's stock was damaged so to it is useless."

"IT WAS QUITE an experience and doesn't make me feel too happy about moving there, but since Tom's work is there, it's where I'll have to go. "A more pleasant memory is the meeting of Ed Sullivan, TV star, who at one time was the office boy of Tom Conners, an associate of Adams. "The Franklin man, who has been in the east for two months, is in charge of the company's eastern division."
