Unethical Sales Practices Bring C of C Warnings

"Do business with firms and persons you know," was the advice given Birmingham and vicinity residents last week by Charles Mortensen, chamber of commerce secretary.

Mortensen and another flood of telephone calls were being received here offering "free" merchandise.

"The system," Mortensen said, "is to tell a person that he or she has been selected to receive a color portrait for whatever the merchandising angle is, usually at no cost."

"As far as it goes, that's fine. We all know no business can operate on a free merchandise basis, so it's reasonable to expect that somehow that businessman is going to get his money back. There's nothing free about it."

"THE SAME applies to the coupon books sold on the promise of greatly reduced prices. The cost probably is lower, but the purchaser finds himself with a lot of coupons for things he doesn't want and can't use."

Mortensen also mentioned house-holders against the current trend toward high-pressure magazine sales.

"Housewives who have received this treatment should call the police at once," Mortensen declared. "Too often they wait until their husbands come home at night to talk it over, and call the next day. By that time the salesman is out of the area."

"CALL THE police immediately, get the license number if you can. Remember what the salesman looked like, what he wore, peculiar mannerisms or other unusual features which will help officers to spot him."

"The safest and happiest method, however, is to confine your trading to firms you know; to firms which are here today and for many days to come. They are reliable and value this reputation."
