## Tip Produces Wanted Man

A 21-year-old man who resisted Birmingham Police last week when they attempted to arrest him on an assault and battery charge, is in Oakland County jail on a charge of carrying concealed weapons, police said.

Raymond Kiddie, no known address, the accused, was apprehended at 2194 Pembroke last Thursday after an unnamed tipster told police that he could be found there.

Kiddie, who is wanted by Bloomfield township police on a charge that he assaulted his wife and took her purse while at the Devon Gallies several days prior to his arrest, had only the night before escaped a police trap.

KIDDIE'S wife had arranged a meeting with him and then told police where they were to meet, but Kiddie slipped through a three-car snare and fled.

When caught at the Pembroke address by Det. Lt. Merin Holquist and Patrolman A. Richard Thomson, Kiddie, Holquist said, attempted to draw a concealed kitchen knife hidden on his person.

The accused man demanded examination of the charge when he appeared before Birmingham Justice John J. Gaffin Friday. Gaffin ordered Kiddie to jail when he failed to post a \$500 bond. Examination was set for Aug. 26.

## Hills Acquiring 2 School Sites

Site for one Bloomfield Hills school district building has been purchased and another optioned, the board of education has announced. Supt. Eugene L. Johnson reported that a 12-acre site on West Long Lake, formerly the Calloway property, has been purchased. It will be the site of a new building, one of five new buildings projected by the district.

ON WESTVIEW road, another

site of a future elementary school has been optioned. The 21 acres are one-quarter mile off Adams, between Squire and Adams, and will serve the Charwood Hills and Kentmore subdivision students.

Bond issue to finance the Westfield school as well as purchase of four or five of the elementary schools and for construction of another Wing Lake addition was discussed by the board.

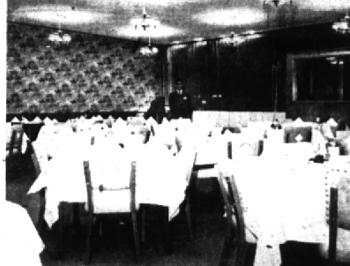
Prior to arrival here the midshipmen completed a three-week training course at the amphibious base, Little Creek, Va.
