Her Friends from Birmingham Welcome Mrs. Shain in West

"When you have friends dotted all over the world, it makes for a lot nicer trip," says Mrs. Charles Shain who returned recently from a summer's trip to California and Minnesota.

Going to attend the national conference of American Association of University Women, she stayed in California to visit old friends from her teaching days there and many Birmingham families who have moved there.

An apartment that she took for herself solved the problem of a rendezvous for friends.

SEEBING CECIL, DeMille director of "The Ten Commandments" was a memorable day for Mrs. Shain.

She describes the crowding of 500 "Israelites," with 20 camels, and herds of sheep and goats on their way to the Promised Land, through a "mountain gorge."

Those acting the "Israelites" parts carried heavy packs, and they pushed along carts piled full of all sorts of rough clothing, much made of hides.

"THIS MADE ME think of my observations in Cairo," Mrs. Shain recalls. "For there, there is evidence of the Israelites in the simple clothing the slaves wear. They are not really slaves, but they do the same drudgery. And the bricks are made as by those early people, centuries before Christ."
