To cost around \$150,000, it will contain 25,000 square feet, and already is about one-third spoken for, according to James W. Jaikins, Jr., secretary of Jaikins Investment Co., which is erecting the building. Of contemporary design, it will be blue-green panel wall and buff-colored brick, two stories. Set back 65 feet from the highway, this air-conditioned structure will have ample parking at the rear and on the north side, will have an automatic elevator and consist of all outside offices. Site preparation has started, and completion is expected by next spring. 'We feel there is a definite need for office space in the North Woodward community,' explained Jaikins, 'and we felt we could supply some of that need with a building in Rirmingsham.'
