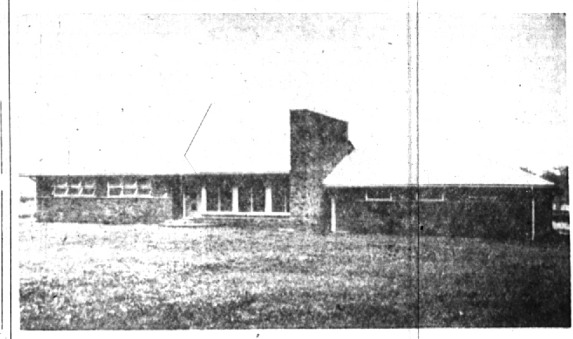
Both Supervisors Dropped by Council
