### Moore Chairmans Archives of Art

Charles F. Moore, Jr., vice-president-public relations, Ford Motor Company, is the new chairman of the Archives of American Art foundation, according to Edgar P. Richardson, director of the Detroit Institute of Arts and of the Archives, an institute project. The Archives of American Art were established in 1954 to make the Detroit Institute of Arts the world center for research material on American art.

In one year, the national research institution has compiled the most important collection of microfilm material on American art in existence.

RICHARDSON noted that the Archives had already attracted significant gifts of material from outside Detroit and that more than \$1,000 microfilm frames had been made of unpublished or out of print and inaccessible material. Each frame represents a page or more of manuscript or printed material.
