**AAUW Book Sale
Brings Large Profit**

Largest net profit in the 25-year history of the annual Book Sale of the Birmingham chapter, American Association of University Women, was reported for the 1955 sale. Committees reported at a meeting last week at the home of Mrs. N. J. Rakas, general chairman.

According to Mrs. E. J. Conway, business manager, this year's sale added \$2,000 to the AAUW Fellowship Fund to assist women students and scholars.

Total showed 11,056 books and 1,068 magazines sold. For the year, each representative year 32 area schools, hospital, and public libraries have been invited to make special selections. This year, the 27 who accepted, sold 1,000 books, 218 magazines, and 112 records for a total cost of \$10,071 which was paid for by a public spirited citizen who wishes to be known only as an anonymous donor.

MRS. RAKAS, after congratulating her coworkers and thanking them for their contribution of time and effort to the success of the sale, announced that the 1956 project was already in the planning stage and named the committees for it.

To Marry Tuesday**

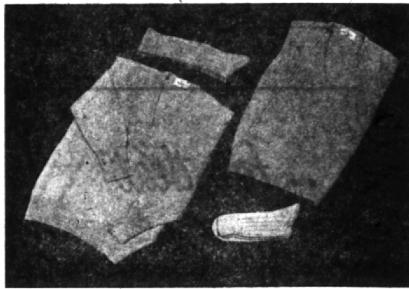

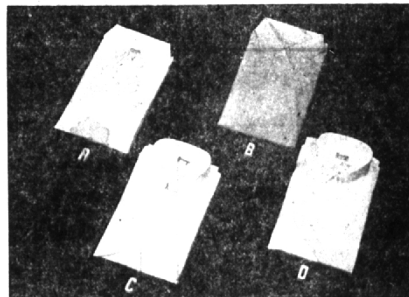
