Will Set Up Vote On Social Utility

A resolution setting up an election in Birmingham city employees can decide whether they want to be covered by federal social security regulations is expected to pass the city council on Jan. 2.

Employees will vote Jan. 11. Police and firemen would not be included in the election, but city provisions still exempt them.

Increase Medical Benefits for City Employees

Increased hospital and medical benefits will apply to Birmingham city employees under improvement adopted this week by city commission.

Cost an estimated \$11,700 annually, it is about \$8,000 more in city participation than the current year. This new figure amount, by about 12 per cent of city pay roll, is a level which the city plans to maintain.
