School Report in May

Studies of immediate classroom needs of the Birmingham public school district, already well under way by the independent citizens committee for education, are expected to be completed by mid-May.

The study group, sponsored by the PTA Council and comprising representatives from all 12 school areas, is concentrating on the immediate need to relieve overcrowded classrooms and alter the possibility of half-day classes.

IT WAS commissioned to study three broad areas: 1) immediate and long-term classroom needs; 2) personnel and 3) curriculum.
