

Cranbrook Wrestling Team Loses to Cleveland U. S.

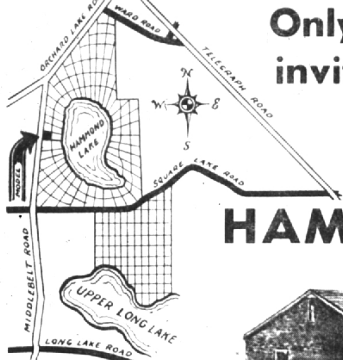

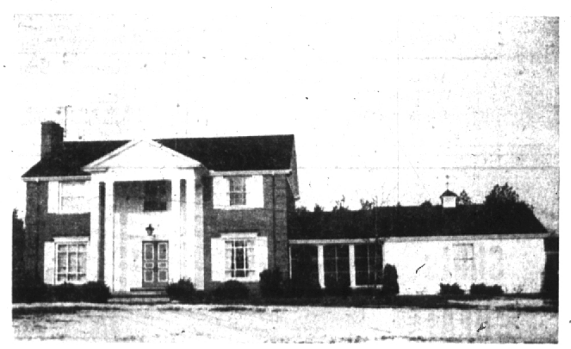
