**AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE**

**OFF STREET PARKING**

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, February 21, 1955, at 8 o'clock P.M. a public hearing will be held in the Commission Room of the Municipal Building in the City of Birmingham, to consider an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 221 with particular reference to an amendment known as No. 466, of the City of Birmingham, requiring the provision of Off-Street Parking for future construction or alteration of business property.

The amendment as proposed will raise the restrictive parking requirements for small buildings and will enlarge the powers of the Zoning Board of Appeals.
