Notice is hereby given that on Monday, February Notice is hereby given that on Monday, February. 21, 1955, at 8 o'clock P.M. a public hearing will be held in the Commission Room of the Municipal Building in the Étty of Birmingham, to consider an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 221 with particular reference to an amendment known as No. 466, of the City of Birmingham, to the City of Birmingham and City of Birming mingham, requiring the provision of Off-Street Parking for feture construction or alteration of business property.

The amendment as proposed will raise the restrictive parking requirements for small buildings and will enlarge the powers of the Zoning Board of Appeals.
