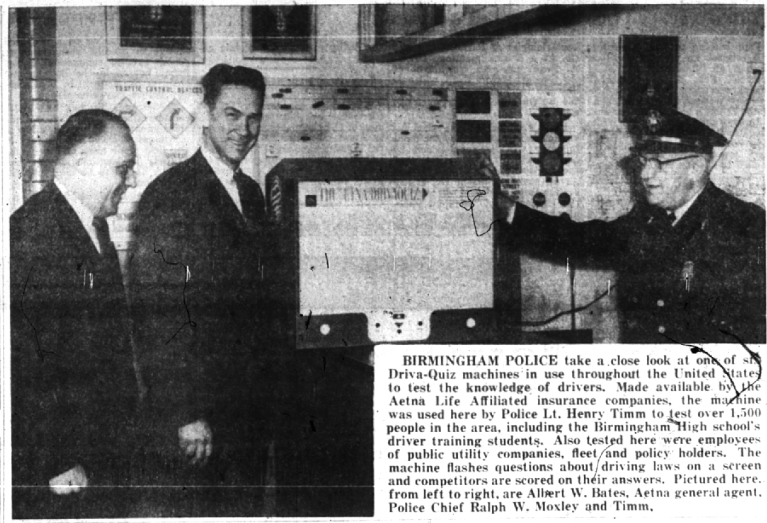


**Volunteers Set Winter Meeting**
