Churches Unite In Observances Of Youth Week

Committees have been meeting since November planning the activities when pastors, laymen and young people laid the groundwork for a special service Feb. 6 at the First Baptist church.

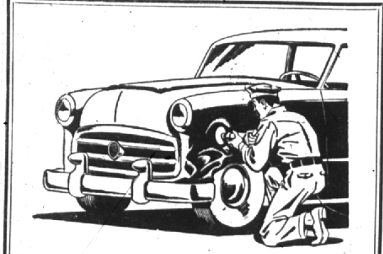

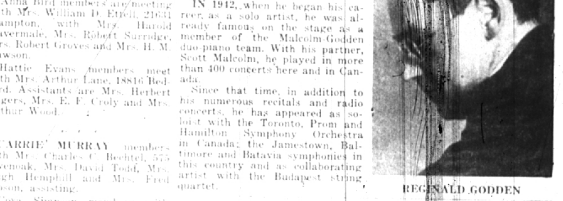
