## Candidates File For Primary Contests

With a primary scheduled in Southfield and only two posts contested in Bloomfield, the largest slate of candidates in the township primary election, February 21, will be in Troy.

According to Township Clerk Fannie Adams, that will be the first year since the township accepted the primary system in 1929 that lack of candidates has released officers from calling a primary. What action will be taken of the proposed initiative measure question to finance the township's share of the Evergreen interceptor will be studied by the township board. The question was to have been submitted to the electors at the primary.

REPUBLICAN nominations for all offices except constable and justice of the peace are filed by incumbents. They are William Decker, supervisor; Fannie Adams, clerk; Clara Lane, treasurer. Trustee posts will be sought by Eugene Swain, Hugh Allerton, J. Margaret Bradbury and H. Luther Wage Wagner.

Seeking the constable position in the April elections will be Thomas Langham with Edward R. Tate nominee for constable. No petitions filed for the board of review post.

DEMOCRATIC aspirants will be John E. Lumps, supervisor; Burdette W. Ezenziel, Raymond G. Hutshins, Howard Coleman and Thomas Kavanagh, trustees.

Edward J. Elvarelli has filed to fill the two year justice vacancy while Wesley J. Simpson will be constable nominee.

Mrs. Bessie M. Griswold offers the only contest to Bloomfield trustees seeking reelection on the Republican ticket. They are Albert A. Clark and Mark R. Kraus.

Also seeking reelection are David E. Anderson, supervisor; Robert H. Dudley, clerk; and Alno L. Hulet, treasurer.

Albert C. Carr and William R. Rodell will be candidates for the justice of the peace post.

IN TROY, Supervisor Norman E. Barnet and Clerk Clifford Truesdell are unopposed for Republican nomination to reelection. Treasurer Fred Hildebrandt will be opposed by George Stueble.

Trustees Lyle Walker, George Ford and Wesley Smith will be joined by Elmer Lowe, Gerald Hannaford, and Donald Formwalt for the Republican bid for trustees.

George Bolton will seek the high way commissioner's post, and Elmer Schroeder will be the Republican Board of review candidate.

SCOTT BELVAE has filed for the justice of the peace term while George Jeffers seeks the vacant JP post. Constable nominees will include Anthony Lubinski, Jr., Dennis Stalvey, Melvin Shook and Michael Cio. All are Republican
