TROY — The Troy Board of Education has decided to issue a call on \$78,000 of the 1949 issue bonds. This will leave \$142,000 outstanding after September 1 on the \$600,000 bond issue, which according to Stuart Baker, Superintendent of Schools, "will leave enough money in reserve to pay off the 1949 bond program."

THE BOARD is considering another bond issue for the ballot this fall and selected the architect firm of Yamasaki, Leinweber and Associates to do the pre-planning of the new issue.
Plans for the fall bond vote call for addition to the high school, junior high school, a new elementary school in south part of the township and an addition to Big Beaver school.

THE AMOUNT of the bond and the date for the voting have not been determined.

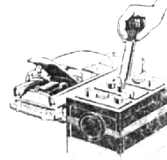
