

Accident Toll Shows Little Gain On 1954

Last month's accident toll showed an improvement over the previous month as well as a better record than June, 1954, according to Ralph W. Mozley, Birmingham police chief.

At the end of the first six months of 1955, however, the accident record for the city is substantially the same as for the first half of 1954, Mozley added.

EACH period saw one fatal accident, while injury accidents were up from 36 to 40 this year, although the number of injured dropped from 48 to 45 persons.

Two violations following too closely, and "right of way" violations have been responsible for a total of 125 of 250 accidents reported this year. There were 11 of the first and five of the latter violations in June alone.

Total accidents last month were 39.

 ORDINANCE NO. 31
 ADOPTED JULY 28, 1955
 AN ORDINANCE FIXING CHARGES FOR WATER AND CONNECTIONS IN BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP

THE TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD

Section 1. The following shall be fixed as the rates for water and connections in Bloomfield Township Water System No. 100, which shall be made available to any user or his agent to the Township Water System No. 100, as shown on a board as may be hereafter designated or determined by the Township Board.

Section 2. For the above charge the Water District will furnish the connection pipe, make the tap in the main and furnish to the owner the key tap valve box and meter. The owner shall install the key tap, valve box and meter and repair all roadway, trench, sidewalks or other things of value damaged by the operation or relation to the installation of any service connection.

Section 3. No work shall be done or connection to the District water system made until a check of the District is received and approved by the Township Board and the rate is paid.

Section 4. No work shall be done or connection to the District water system made until a check of the District is received and approved by the Township Board and the rate is paid.

Section 5. Any plumber making tap or connection to the District water system shall be under the supervision of a plumber or other person designated by the Township Board.

Section 6. All materials used in any connection shall be of the best quality and conform to the specifications of the Township Board.

Section 7. The Township Board may at any time suspend or revoke the license of any plumber or other person designated by the Township Board.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, and shall apply to all connections made on or after the date of its passage.
