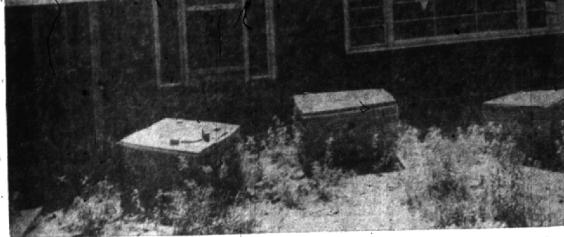
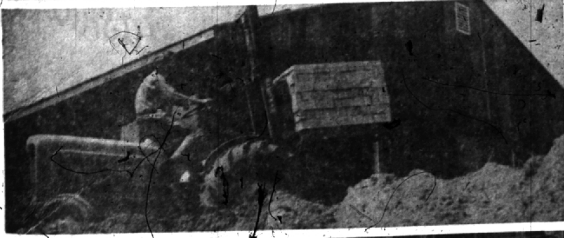


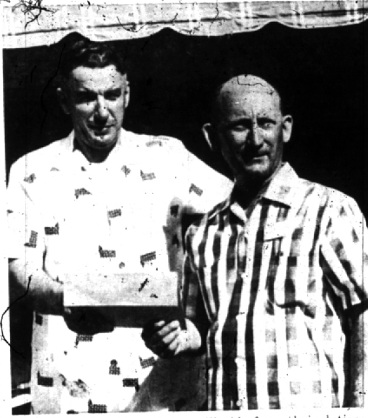

'Spotting' Bricks on Job Saves Time, Money, Effort

Jake Kutchai, owner of Eton Brick & Supply, says that "extra care" which has proved to be a "trick" and brought in new business. He doesn't just dump a load of bricks in a corner of a job, but he spots them here and there about the project. This "palletizing" system works like this: He loads 630 to 720 much faster job. They can keep trucks on pallets right from the freight car platform to the building site. He has the truck or chopper hook in making it fit. And he contracts for extra money distributing the pallets, "chop in" where the masons want the brick too? This is due to less breakage of brick, less time wasted by the masons and less handling time needed. NOT ONLY are handling costs reduced but most important of all, it saves money because of the increased business because of the improved delivery system. In the improved delivery system, the masons enjoy a brick, thus eliminating the pallets.
