After cake and ice cream, each was given a small whistle boat, and after a big swoop down the slide into the pool, they played with their boats in the water.

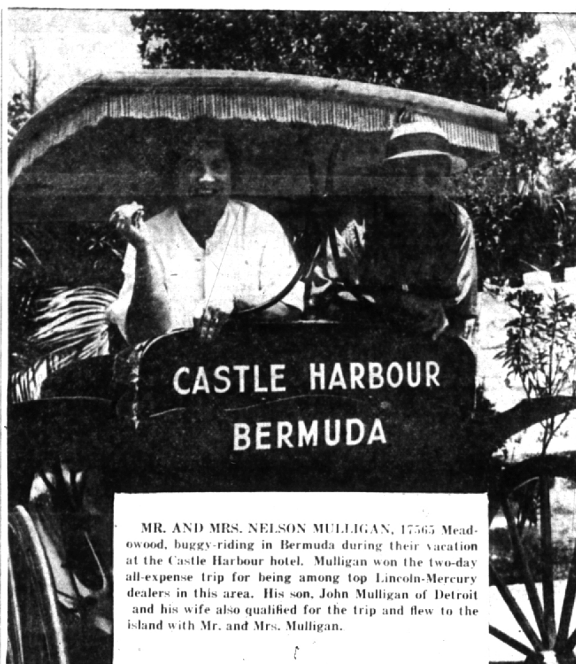

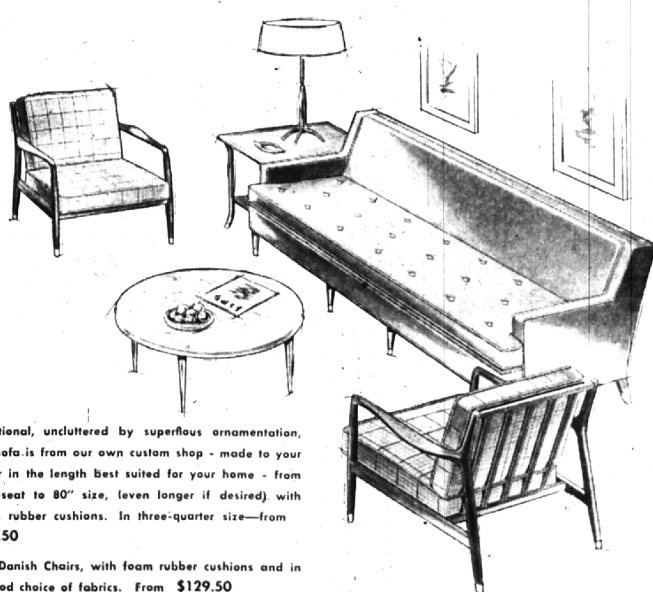
