OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 FRACTIONAL, TOWNSHIPS OF BLOOMFIELD, TROY AND WEST BLOOMFIELD, AND CITY OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS, COUNTY OF OAKLAND, MICHIGAN ON MONDAY, JULY 11, 1955.

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT:

Please Take Notice that at a Special Election to be held in School District No. 2, Fractional, Townships of Bloomfield, Troy and West Bloomfield, and City of Bloomfield Hills, County of Oakland, Michigan, on Monday, July 11, 1955, the following proposition will be submitted to vote of the qualified electors of said School District:

"Shall School District No. 2, Fractional, Townships of Bloomfield, Troy and West Bloomfield, and City of Bloomfield Hills, County of Oakland, Michigan, borrow the sum of not exceeding Eight Hundred Thousand (\$800,000.00) Dollars and issue its bonds therefor for the purpose of erecting and furnishing an elementary school building and an addition to the Wing Lake School, remodeling the Vaughan School, acquiring additional school sites and improving existing school sites, and furnishing of the High School Building in said District?"

Each person voting on the above bonding proposition must be—

- (a) A citizen of the United States of America over twenty-one (21) years of age;
- (b) A resident of the State of Michigan for six (6) months and of the School District for thirty (30) days prior to the date of the election.
- (c) Have properly assessed for taxes within the School District, or be the lawful husband or wife of each owner.
- (d) A registered elector in the City or Township in which he resides.
