

B'ham Motorist Among Weekend Auto Fatalities

Two motorists, one of them a Birmingham resident, were pronounced dead on arrival at Pontiac General Hospital Sunday of injuries suffered when their cars crashed head-on about one-quarter mile north of Walnut Lake road on Middlebelt.

Killed were: Allen R. Warbler, 56, of 2185 Lincoln. Robert M. Jovan, 23, of Detroit. Warbler's wife, Maurine, 47, was reported in fair condition with fractured ribs, and jaw, and severe forehead cuts.

WEST BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP police said Jovan's northbound car apparently swerved over the center line, as he rounded hilly curve, into the path of the Warbler auto.

Jovan's car burst into flames after overturning into a ditch. West Bloomfield firemen fought the blaze for about an hour, police said. The Detroit car was alone in the car which witnesses said was traveling at a high rate of speed.

Surviving besides his wife is a daughter, Allene; five sisters, Mrs. Clarence Kinsman, Mrs. May Lawson, Mrs. John Tachell, Mrs. Shirley Stock and Mrs. Frank Shaw; and one brother, Raymond Warbler.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m., today, at the Ross E. Northrop and Son funeral home, 22401 Grand River. Burial will be in White Chapel cemetery.
