To Receive Doctorate

Tomorrow the Birmingham school system can boast of having three doctors on its staff—Dr. Dwight B. Ireland, superintendent of Birmingham schools; Dr. Richard Featherstone, administrative assistant to the superintendent's office, formerly principal of Turley school; and the new and last doctor—Dr. Paul D. Carter.

Carter, assistant superintendent in charge of instruction of the Birmingham schools, receives a doctor's degree in education tonight from Wayne university.

HE HAS BEEN with the Birmingham school system for 13 years. He received an A.B. degree from Ypsilanti State Teachers College in 1936 and his master's degree in education from the University of Michigan in 1939.

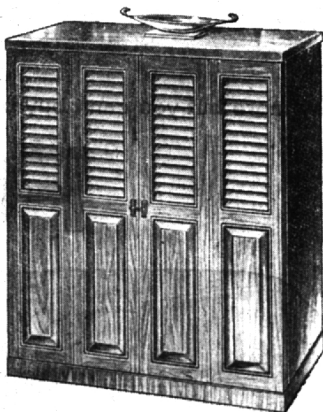
Carter came to Birmingham from Northville in 1942 to become principal of Adams school. In 1950 he went to the central office to become director of elementary education and for the past three years has been in charge of instruction as assistant superintendent.

For the past seven years, Carter has worked on his doctorate and used as his field study and original research work required for the degree, a study of the Birmingham school curriculum.

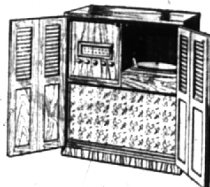
