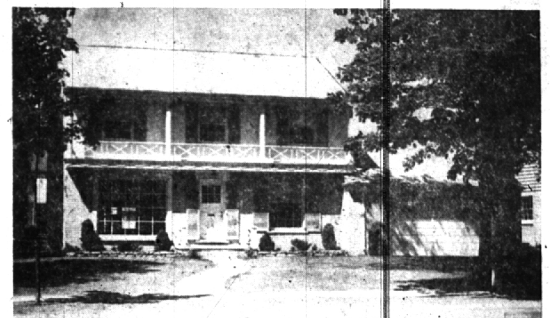

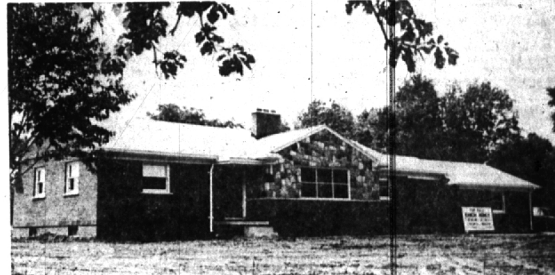

ANOTHER HONORABLE mention went to Mrs. R. A. Robeson, for a sgrafitto dish.

Underglazing honorable mention went to Mrs. Virginia Sutherland of Detroit for a modern pitcher, and Mrs. Lee Charles for a modern plate.

Children's division, winners, members of a Girl Scout troop, were Nancy McClurg, Green Lake; first for a sculptured llama; Barbara Bowers, Green Lake, second for a hand made tile; Betsy Krause, third for an underglaze plate; and Linda Warren, of Pontiac, honorable mention for a sculptured elephant.

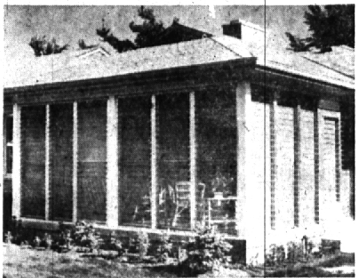

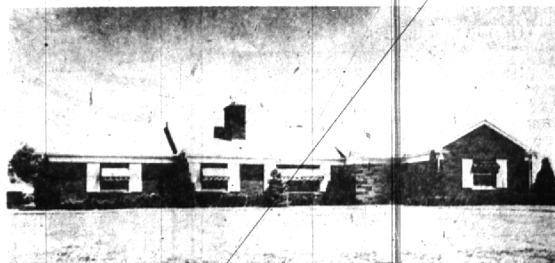
