Simpson, who finds the three languages spoken in the German sector of the Swiss land difficult, will be joining his wife and children there later. Mrs. Simpson and the youngsters will leave here by plane on Monday, and he will follow on July 15, with all returning on July 26 aboard the trans-oceanic liner Liberté.

The Simpsons met in Berne, Switzerland, when he was stationed at the American Legation and she was working with the American Red Cross. She and her

## NOTICE

OF LAST DAY OF REGISTRATION OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2, FRACTIONAL, TOWNSHIPS OF BLOOMFIELD, TROY AND WEST BLOOMFIELD, AND CITY OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS, COUNTY OF OAKLAND, MICHIGAN, FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MONDAY, JULY 11, 1955.

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT:

Please Take Notice that a Special Election will be held in said School District on Monday, July 11, 1955.

Section (2) of Act 199, Public Acts of Michigan, 1951, provides as follows:

"The Inspectors of Election at any annual or special election shall not receive the vote of any person residing in a registration school district whose name is not registered as an elector in the city or township in which he resides."

THE LAST DAY on which persons may register with the appropriate city or township clerk in order to be eligible to vote at the Special Election to be held on July 11, 1955, is Friday, July 1, 1955. Persons registering after 5:00 o'clock p.m., Eastern Standard Time, on said Friday, July 1, 1955, will not be eligible to vote at said Special School Election.

Under the provisions of Act 199, Public Acts of Michigan, 1951, registrations will not be taken by School officials, and only persons who have registered as general electors with the appropriate city or township clerk of the city or township in which they reside are registered school electors. Persons planning to register with the city or township clerk must ascertain the days and hours on which the clerk's office is open for registration.

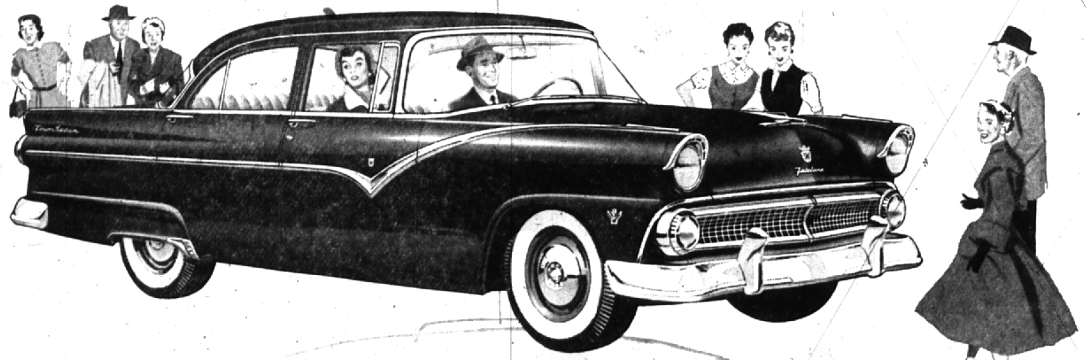

OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2, FRACTIONAL, TOWNSHIPS OF BLOOMFIELD, TROY AND WEST BLOOMFIELD, AND CITY OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS, COUNTY OF OAKLAND, MICHIGAN ON MONDAY, JULY 11, 1955.

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT:

Please Take Notice that at a Special Election to be held in School District No. 2, Fractional, Townships of Bloomfield, Troy and West Bloomfield, and City of Bloomfield Hills, County of Oakland, Michigan, on Monday, July 11, 1955, the following proposition will be submitted to vote of the qualified electors of said School District:

"Shall School District No. 2, Fractional, Townships of Bloomfield, Troy and West Bloomfield, and City of Bloomfield Hills, County of Oakland, Michigan, borrow the sum of not exceeding Eight Hundred Thousand (\$800,000.00) Dollars and issue its bonds therefor for the purpose of creating and furnishing an elementary school building and an addition to the Wing Lake School, remodeling the Vaughan School, acquiring additional school sites and improving existing school sites, and furnishing of the High School Building in said District?"

Each person voting on the above bonding proposition must be—

- (a) A citizen of the United States of America over twenty-one (21) years of age;
- (b) A resident of the State of Michigan for six (6) months and of the School District for thirty (30) days prior to the date of the election.
- (c) Have property assessed for taxes within the School District, or be the lawful husband or wife of each owner.
- (d) A registered elector in the City or Township in which he resides.
