

Little Marian Johnson, eight years old, was not to be outdone, however. She decided that the American peritage of free competition was needed.

Last Saturday a stand was up on the Johnson sidewalk with Marian as the proprietor. After six hours of transient trade, she found her profits reached \$1.40 for the day, with fifty cents worth of credit she gave to friends and family.
