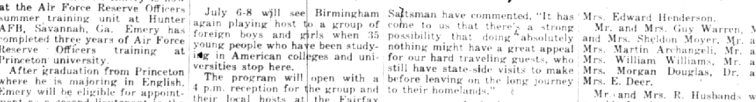
**Foreign Group Comes July 6 To Visit Here**

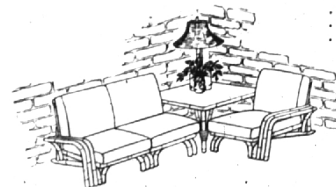
