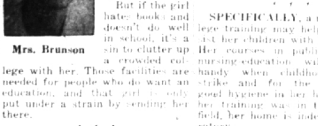
We didn't think we'd hear this one again. "Shall I send my daughter to college?" but it's back again in the public prints and, therefore, in the public mind.
