# Cadets Eligible For Jet Training

Hoping to "motivate civil air patrol cadets toward a career in aviation" the Air Force is sponsoring a week of pre-flight jet training for a limited group of highly qualified male cadets.

The enrollment will be at Tyndall Air Force base July 23 through Aug. 1.

To obtain only the two top cadets from each state, qualifications are extremely rigid. All applicants must be in top physical condition, high school graduates, and hold CAP's highest cadet award, the certificate of proficiency.

Mike Koskinen and Bill Hegner, two Birmingham cadets meet all qualifications and are eligible for consideration by the state screening board.

The two cadets representing Michigan will be rewarded with five hours of flight orientation in jet aircraft, flight simulator training, altitude chamber orientation and visits to the base controller center and pre-mission groups.

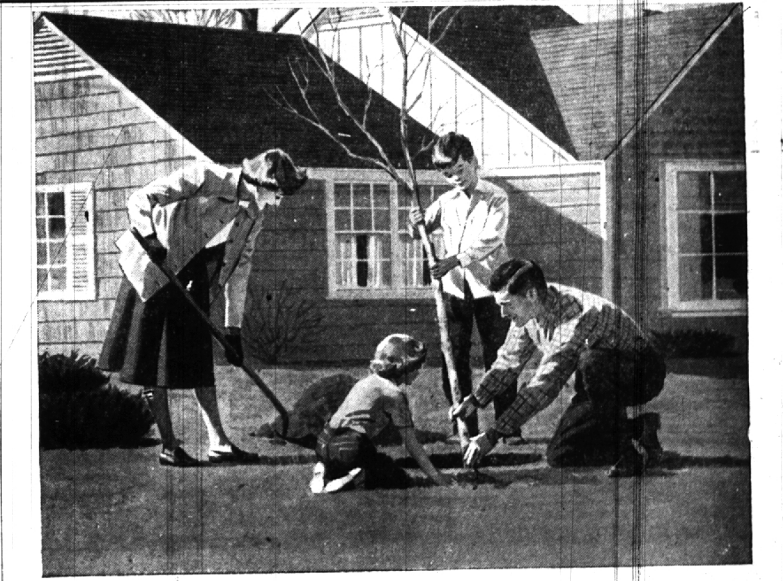

**TIMELY TIP ON TREE CARE**

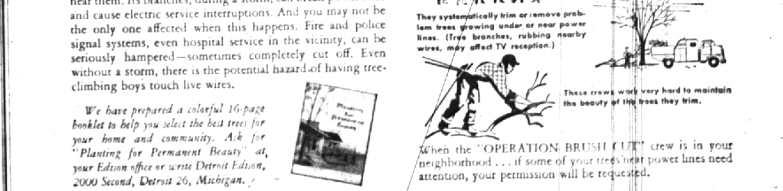
Don't leave a stub when pruning. When trimmed branches are more than an inch in diameter, paint the wounds with shellac or tree compound.
