**RIDING TO WORK** on the commuter train is pretty much of a day-in-day-out routine, varied only by the weather. But conversation and the day's news in the morning paper. But once in a while circumstances occur over which no one has any control—such as grade crossing accidents, or as in the case last Thursday, a broken connecting rod on the locomotive. So hundreds of Birmingham area passengers were among those late for work by as much as 90 minutes. It was during the time Wendorph was on the commission that he interceded to get the first water meters in the homes of Birmingham, the Woodward avenue pavement poured from Lincoln to Oak street, and worked on the landscaping of the West Maple-Southfield avenue park.
