When Sister Francesca came from Toronto to address a group of women at St. James Episcopal church Monday afternoon...

Coronation Mass by St. James Choir

MOZART'S "Coronation Mass" will be presented at 4 p.m., March 20, by the senior choir of St. James Episcopal church. This is the third in the series of music vesper for the Lenten season.

St. McDonald's director, said soloists would be Nina Sherman, soprano; Marc Wilson, contralto; Neil Soper, tenor; and George Mullin, bass.

Mozart composed the "Mass" in 1779 for the small church of Maria Theresia, near Salzburg, Austria. The church for years was famous as a shrine and according to tradition, a miraculous appearance of the Virgin had occurred there.

Collegio Americana Has Partial Support From Local Church

This mass is performed annually by the cathedral of Salzburg and Vienna as part of the Christmas Eve midnight service.

He (Mozart) said that, so far as he has been able to determine, the St. James presentation brings the "Coronation Mass" to this area for the first time.
