

YMCA Cage League Ends Eliminations

Following Monday night's play-offs in the YMCA church basketball league, First Methodist church and Congregational church of Birmingham gained places in the final play-offs to be held March 29 and April 4.

In Monday night's games, Lutheran Church of the Redeemer defeated a favored Southfield quintet 37-21 to gain a three-way tie for third place with First Baptist Church.

THE LUTHERAN aggregation took a 24-14 halftime lead following a second period scoring spree in which they netted 14 points to Southfield's 6.

Tom Sheehan's 15 points topped the scoring column with teammate Doug Wiggazzer's 11 points running a close second. Top score for Southfield was Richardson with a 7 point total.

The second game of the evening saw unbeaten First Methodist adding another win to its string-by defeating St. James 39-26. The Methodist boys took a 12-1 lead as the first quarter and were never seriously challenged.
