

A. H. Roessling to Aid Designers

Adolph H. Roessling, of Eastmoor road, has been appointed official representative of the trustees of the Pontiac General Hospital in consultation with architect Leo J. Heenan, on designs for the new hospital wing.

Roessling is connected with the Detroit firm of Smith, Hinchman and Grylls, Inc., as principal architect and project director, in charge of the Lansing Civic Center and St. Lawrence Nurses' Home, the Presbyterian Village and Two People's Community Hospital projects, in Allen Park and Wayne.

DURING WORLD WAR II, he had charge of planning and construction of hospitals and clinics in the Middle East working from his post in the surgeon general's office. Following the war he planned the new Henry Ford Diagnostic Clinic in Detroit, and hospitals in New England and South America.

The Roesslings, who have two daughters, Mary Margaret, 10, and Kathleen, 9, moved to their home on Eastmoor road three years ago.

Plan 91 Homes in Adams Village

Construction of 91 homes on Bowler and Hazel in Adams Village Subdivision will begin as soon as sewer and water contracts have been awarded, according to Harry Green, co-owner of the developing concern, Quality Built Homes of Berkeley.

Green, who last week announced the purchase of the land from Reed Paterson, said water and sewer contracts should be awarded within 30 days.

The six-room ranch homes will be built on 23-80 x 137 foot lots and each will have full basement with lavatory, outside face brick, full tile bath and separate breakfast nook.

Start Work on 600 Westchester Lots

The Howard T. Keating Company has taken charge of sales in "Westchester Village," which includes 600 lots on the old Mercier Farm just west of the Birmingham City limits.

Eleven builders will begin construction immediately on the suburban-type homes. Each lot will be about one-half acre in size and will be serviced by water, sewers, gas and black top pavements with curbs.
