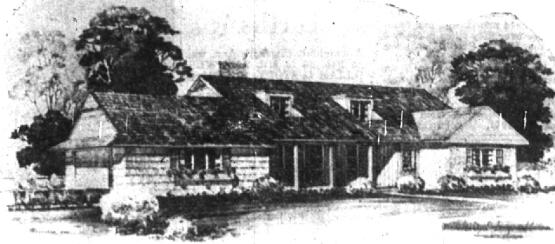
### Plan Board Gets Street Problem

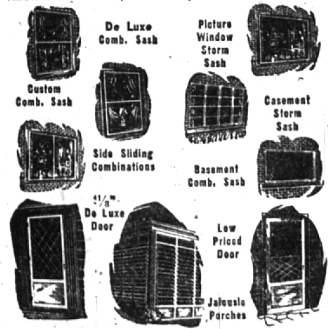

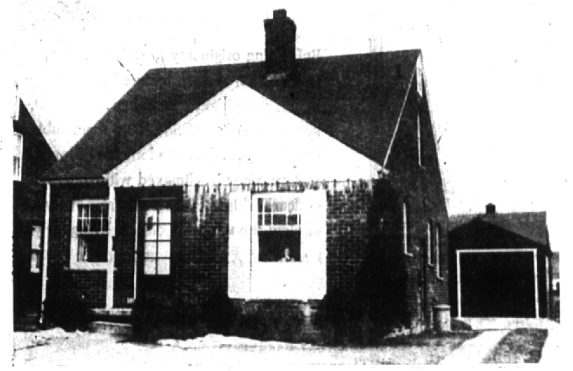
