Waives Hearing On Theft Charge
 A 34-year-old Detroit woman, who has worked in the Birmingham area for two years, last Friday admitted that she took \$1,000 worth of Dresden china from her employer, according to Birmingham objectives.
 The accused, Mrs. Erma Senter, (also Erma Sanders) waived examination before Justice John J. Gaffill, who set bond at \$500 and bound the woman over to Oakland County circuit court. Mrs. Senter, unable to provide bond, is being held in Oakland County jail.
 According to Det. Lt. Merlin Holmquist and Det. Robert Schulte, Mrs. Senter admitted to Assistant Oakland County Prosecutor Gerard Puchman that she took the dishes from the home of Mrs. Maude Unruh of 587 Linden, last March.
 HOLMQUIST said the china was recovered in an apartment which Mrs. Senter was renting in Detroit.
 "When hiring domestic servants, employers should check thoroughly their references and obtain more information about the person they are hiring," said Holmquist in warning to Birmingham residents. "Too many hire persons that come in and stay only a few days and leave with something of value." Mrs. Senter is wanted by the Wayne County Recorder's court for violation of probation in connection with a bad check conviction, Holmquist added.
